

Unpack your carousel and check to make sure you have all the parts

- 1. Upright
- 2. Legs (4)
- 3. Leveling Feet (4)
- 4. Base (welded to the upright)
- 5. Top plate
- 6. Spinner Hub (attached to the top plate) (patent pending)
- 7. Long arms (6 or 12)
- 8. ID Tabs (6 or 12)
- 9. Arm extensions with scent cup rings (6 or 12)
- 10. Scent cups (6 or 12)
- 11. Fastener package

## Basic Assembly

Note: Parts may appear slightly different from those shown as we continue to improve the training carousel

#### Attach one leveling foot to each leg



Insert the legs in the base of the upright, and secure with large bolts







Insert the upright through the center hole of the top plate, lower the top plate to desired height and secure with pin.







# Attach the desired number of arms and secure with the short bolts and wing nuts





Insert a short arm into each long arm and secure in place with a thumbscrew

Insert a scent cup into each ring holder and secure in place with thumbscrew





Place ID Tab under the top plate at the base of each arm. Loosen bolts to slide under then tighten again.



you will need to apply your own numbers to the ID Tabs



## Adjusting your detection wheel

You can  $\cdot$  Adjust the height of the carousel  $\cdot$  Adjust the length of the arms  $\cdot$  Rotate the top plate or lock it in place  $\cdot$  Level the carousel 16

Adjust the height by securing the top plate higher or lower on the upright. 17





Adjusting arm length

Adjust the length of the arms by sliding the arm extensions in and out – cups are about 2 feet apart with arms fully extended. 18





Remove vertical locking pin to rotate the top plate. Insert pin to lock top plate in place. 19

Locking the top plate



Leveling the carousel

Level the carousel using the leveling feet on the bottom of each leg. 20
